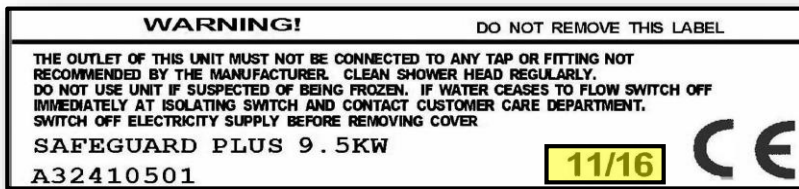


IMPORTANT PRODUCT SAFETY WARNING

We believe you may have one of these products

It has come to our attention that in a very small number of cases the Safeguard+ may develop a fault which could lead to overheating and to a potential risk of electric shock or fire hazard.

If your shower is showing any signs of discolouration; you MUST stop using this immediately and contact us as below:

How to check the model / serial number:

Affected units start with the product code CSGP0 and have a date code stamp between 05/14 (May 2014) to 12/16 (December 2016). This date code is on the product rating label located on the underside of the product. [see image above]

What should I do if my shower is affected?

- If you have an affected shower; please contact us for details of how we will make the modification completely free of charge.
- Any overheating is gradual and is noticeable with a distinct overheating smell.
- You should check the casing top to see if there are any signs of discolouration. If there is none, then you can continue to use the shower.
- Please continue to ensure that any vulnerable people are not left showering alone and that user instructions continue to be followed.
